Prof. Thomas Luger

Senior Professor, Dept. of Dermatology
University of Münster, Münster, Germany

Professor Thomas Luger obtained his MD from Vienna University, where he was Resident and Assistant Professor of Dermatology. He is currently Senior Professor, Department of Dermatology, University of Münster and director of the Institute of Cell Biology and Immunobiology of the Skin at Münster University. His clinical interest is focused on allergic inflammation and autoimmune diseases of the skin, and his main areas of research are the role of cytokines and neuropeptides in the regulation of the function of dendritic cells on immune tolerance.

He is the Past-President of the German Society of Dermatology and Editor of the journal *Experimental Dermatology*. He is a former Dean of the Medical Faculty of the Westphalian Wilhelms University Münster and Member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences, Member of the German Academy of Natural Science Leopoldina, and Member of the Northrhine-Westphalian Academy of Sciences and was awarded the title of "Doctor honoris causa" by the Medical School of the University of Athens and is member of the Board of Directors of the International League of Dermatological Societies.

Dr. David Luk Chi-kong is the Consultant Paediatrician of the United Christian Hospital, Hong Kong. He is also the Honorary Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Hong Kong and the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Dr Luk earned his medical degree from the Chinese University of Hong Kong and subsequently obtained his membership of the Royal Colleges of Physicians (UK) and of the Royal College of Paediatric and Child Health (UK). He completed his postgraduate diploma in dermatological sciences at the University of Wales under Prof. Andrew Finlay, and a Master of Science in dermatology at Cardiff University, UK. He undertook training in dermatology at the Great Ormond Street Hospital of London under Prof. John Harper.

Dr Luk is President of the Hong Kong Paediatric and Adolescent Dermatology Society. He is also a Fellow of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine and the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians. Dr Luk's particular interest lies in paediatric dermatology and he is a published author in areas of dermatology and paediatrics.
