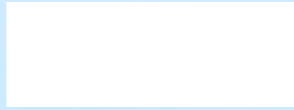

# Our Speakers



**Associate Professor Chong Chia Yin**  
*MBBS, MMed (Paediatrics), MRCP, FAMS, FRCPCH*

Associate Professor Chong Chia Yin is the Director of Clinical Quality and Patient Safety, Division of Medicine and senior consultant of the Infectious Disease service, Department of Paediatrics at KKH. She is chairman of the Ministry of Health (MOH) Expert Committee on Immunization, and also a member of MOH Expert committee on COVID-19 vaccination, Bioterrorism threats, pandemic influenza and member of the Hospital Infection Control Committee. She is also the Patient Safety champion and chairman of the QI network at KKH.

She is also appointed adjunct associate professor at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore, at Duke- NUS Graduate Medical School and Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University.

She received the Singapore Health Quality Service Gold Award (SHQSA) 2021, COVID 19 Healthcare Hero 2021 and the Singhealth Residency Outstanding Faculty Award for Academic year 2016-2017. Her other awards include: National Day Long service award 2016, Top 10 abstracts Award at 7th International Congress of the Asia Pacific Society of Infection Control 2015, excellent service awards, Singhealth Quality Service 2012, Singhealth scientific meeting best oral paper 2005, KKH annual scientific meeting free paper merit award 2011.

She received her training in Pediatrics in Singapore and Infectious Diseases in Boston, USA. She is also a Certified Professional in Healthcare Quality, USA.

In research, Associate Professor Chong has published more than 100 infectious disease articles including COVID-19 infection, influenza, pertussis, antimicrobial stewardship, Zika virus outbreak, hand, foot and mouth disease (HFMD), adenovirus, pneumonia, vaccine-preventable infections, invasive pneumococcal disease, BCG complications and prevention of HIV transmission from mother to child.



**Dr. Chong Sze Yee**  
*Expert panel for Malaysia Paediatric Association (MPA)  
for the IMFeD Paediatrician Gastroenterologist, Hospital Pulau Pinang*

Dr. Chong Sze Yee obtained his undergraduate degree from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia in 1999 and completed his postgraduate studies in paediatrics in 2008 in University Malaya. After that, he served in various hospitals including Hospital Sultanah Aminah, Johor Bahru from 2008 to 2010.

In the year of 2010, he started his training in Paediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology & Nutrition in University Malaya until mid-2011 followed by further training in Hospital Selayang until the end of 2012. Subsequently, he spent a year completing his advance training in Paediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology & Nutrition in Royal Children's Hospital Melbourne, Australia. After that, he served as Paediatrician Gastroenterologist in the Dept of Paediatrics, Hospital Pulau Pinang. Currently he is affiliated with Hospital Raja Permaisuri Banun Ipoh and as inviting Paediatrician Gastroenterologist Consultant in Pantai Ipoh Hospital.

Dr. Chong is a member of the expert panel for Malaysia Paediatric Association (MPA) for the IMFeD ( identification & management of children with feeding difficulties ) programme. He sat in the committees which produced guideline including The Guideline for the Management of Cow's milk protein allergy in 2012 which was endorsed by Malaysia Paediatric association (MPA) and Malaysia Society of Allergy & Immunology (MSAI). Dr. Chong loves teaching & have given many lectures in various courses, workshops and meetings. He is also active in research with publication in various journals.



**Associate Professor Dr. Ng Ruey Terng**  
*Consultant Paediatric Gastroenterologist & Hepatologist,  
Universiti Malaya Medical Center*

Associate Professor Dr. Ng is a senior medical lecturer in the Department of Paediatrics, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya and a consultant paediatrician in the Department of Paediatrics, University of Malaya Medical Centre (UMMC). After completing paediatric specialist training in Malaysia, he spent 1 1/2 years with the Paediatric Gastroenterology Unit and Liver Unit at Birmingham Children's Hospital, Birmingham, United Kingdom. He is currently the head of Unit of Paediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition of UMMC, the clinical lead in paediatric liver transplant program of UMMC and Specialty Subcommittee Member for Paediatric Gastroenterology of National Specialist Register (NSR), Ministry of Health Malaysia.





**Dr. Rolf Bos**

*Director Development - Expert Nutrition Team*

Dr. Rolf Bos has a MSc degree in Biochemistry and holds a PhD degree in Medical Sciences from Groningen University in the Netherlands (1996) in the area of microbial adhesion. He started his professional career as an assistant professor at the University of Groningen expanding his experience in biomaterials. In 1999 he joined FrieslandCampina. At FrieslandCampina, he has set up and developed the Nutrition discipline. In his current position, he is responsible for the Global Nutrition Expert team (Wageningen, Singapore, China) and the Frieslandcampina Institute aimed at stimulating knowledge exchange amongst Health Care professionals. Dr. Sergio Díaz Madero is Pediatric Gastroenterologist, graduated from the National Institute of Pediatrics in Mexico City. He has a master degree in human Microbiota from the CEU University Cardenal Herrera in Valencia, Spain. He is currently Professor of Pediatrics and Gastroenterology at the Spanish Hospital of Mexico and Hospital Angeles Lomas, both affiliated with La Salle University. He has published several papers in international journals and participated as speaker at national and international congresses and symposia. He develops his clinical practice as a Pediatric Gastroenterologist at Unidad de Pediatría in Mexico city.



**Professor Yvan Vandenplas**

*University Hospital Brussels (UZ Brussel)  
Chair of the ESPGHAN Special Interest Group*

Professor Yvan Vandenplas studied medicine and trained in pediatrics (1981-1986) at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel. He became Head of the Unit for Pediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition in 1987, and is Head of the KidZ Health Castle at the University Hospital Brussels (UZ Brussel) and the Chair of Pediatrics 1994 - 2022. Yvan's main interests are gastro-esophageal reflux (diagnostic procedures, treatment), eosinophilic esophagitis, infant nutrition, probiotics and prebiotics, cow's milk protein allergy, functional gastrointestinal disorders and *Helicobacter pylori*. He has published many original research and review papers on topics such as infant nutrition, gastro-esophageal reflux and functional gastrointestinal disorders. He is now one of the associate editors of the Journal of Paediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition. He is also the chair of the ESPGHAN Special Interest Group on "Gut Microbiota & Modifications". Yvan has more than 450 publications listed in Medline, and over 1000 oral presentations at different international meetings.
